

Instructions for Sending Biological Materials for Animal Vaccine Production for Deposit

Confidential deposit

1. Deposit form

Submit a signed deposit form together with biological material.

2. Biological material

- 2.1. Biological materials are contained in 1.5 – 2.0 ml screw cap cryotubes with O-ring or sealing ring ready for preservation by freezing.
- 2.2. Biological material name and/or code and date of preservation must be printed on the surface of cryotubes or self-adhesive stickers and should remain legible when stored in frozen condition and contact with moisture and water. Each label should be further secured with a layer of sealing film or clear tape.
- 2.3. Send at least 10 tubes per sample.
- 2.4. During transportation, biological materials must be maintained below -70°C. Biological material classified in risk group 2 must be packed and shipped according to national biosafety and biosecurity regulations or IATA Dangerous Goods Regulations.
